Regional Transportation Coordinating Councils (RTCCs)

The Minnesota Departments of Transportation, in collaboration with other state agencies, worked with the Metropolitan Council and other local governments and organizations, public and private, to create Regional Transportation Coordinating Councils throughout Minnesota.

Coordination between public, private and non-profit transportation providers and service agencies is a strategy that can help fill transportation gaps. This results in more rides using the same or fewer resources, making transportation easier to use and giving customers more options of where and when to travel.

What does the Region 4 RTCC do for our area?

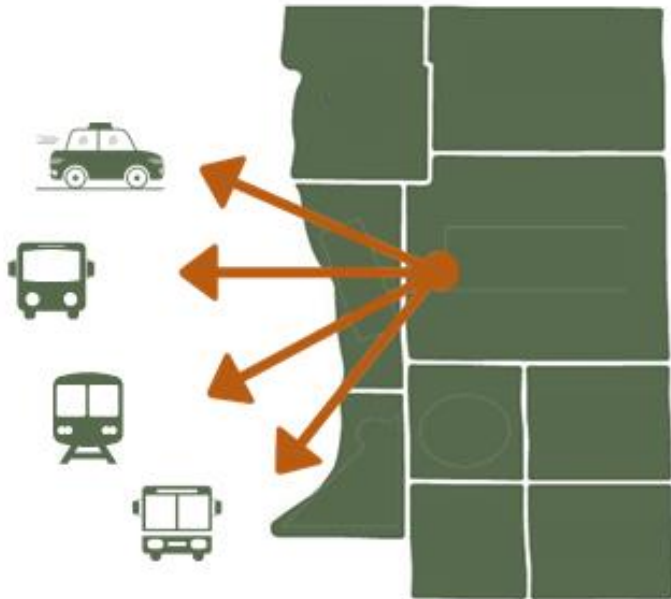


- ✓ Identify unmet transportation needs
